## Warren's Two New Fire Stations set to open in Spring of 2025!

The site for Warren's new Fire Station 1, 23232 Van Dyke, north of Nine Mile Road, is next to the Civic Center South complex and completes the final phase of that project. This location gives emergency vehicles direct access to Van Dyke, allowing for better response times.

Warren's new Fire Station 5, 30619 Schoenherr Road, north of Common Road, replaces the outdated station located at Hoover and Common Roads. This station will enable the fire department to better serve the northeast quadrant of the city, which has the highest call volume.




