Suspect in custody after police pursuit – Uninvolved motorist pronounced deceased from crash

The Warren Police Department would like to provide an initial update regarding a vehicle pursuit which resulted in fatality to an uninvolved motorist at 9 Mile and Van Dyke. The suspect involved in this incident is in the custody of the Warren Police Department. The intersection of 9 Mile and Van Dyke is expected to be closed for several hours while investigators continue to process this scene.

The preliminary investigation shows that, at approximately 9:33 PM tonight (05/24/2025), two uniformed Warren Police officers in a fully marked patrol car observed a black Chrysler 300 driving recklessly in the area of Van Dyke and Miller. Officers attempted to initiate a traffic stop by activating their emergency equipment, but the Chrysler failed to stop, leading to a vehicle pursuit.

The suspect vehicle traveled northbound on Van Dyke before turning southbound. At the intersection of 9 Mile and Van Dyke, the Chrysler collided with an uninvolved motorist's vehicle and a secondary vehicle. Following the crash, the suspect fled on foot but was quickly apprehended by officers without further incident.

The driver of the uninvolved vehicle, a 71-year-old female, was transported to a local hospital where she was pronounced deceased from her injuries. The occupants of the secondary vehicle did not sustain serious injuries.

The Warren Police Department Traffic Crash Reconstruction Unit is currently processing the scene. The intersection of 9 Mile Road and Van Dyke is expected to remain closed for several more hours as investigators continue their work.
